ORGANIZATION ELIGIBILITY

Open to Montgomery County:

- 501c3 nonprofit organizations
- Schools
- Colleges and universities
- Municipalities and government agencies
- Collectives and other unincorporated groups with a 501c3 nonprofit, tax-exempt fiscal agent

Not open to:

- Arts/cultural organizations (or their auxiliary groups) that receive operating support through the MCACD
- Small Businesses
- Individuals

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY

- MCACD providing \$300,000 for the 2023 cycle
- Grants of up to \$10,000 for arts and cultural projects
- Funded projects must:
 - Take place in Montgomery County
 - Take place between July 1, 2023 and June 30, 2024
- Can be new or repeat projects
- Types of projects:
 - Cultural/Multi-arts
 - Education
 - Literary Arts/Performing Arts
 - Visual Arts
 - Capacity Building (arts/cultural orgs only)

PROJECT ELIGIBILITY

Capacity Building Projects

- Allowed:
 - Strategic planning
 - Professional development training for staff and board members
 - Marketing plan and website development
 - Market research or feasibility studies
- Not Allowed:
 - Capital expenses (purchasing, repairing, or maintaining land, buildings, or equipment)

FAQs

- Common uses of grant funds: artist fees, venue rentals, art supplies, marketing materials and services, staff time
- No matching funding requirement for nonprofit organizations or schools
- 1:1 **cash** match required for colleges/universities, municipalities, and government agencies
- Only one project per applicant
- Only one application per project
- Final report due 30 days after project end date

July 2023 – First grant payments

June 30, 2024 – Project must be complete

Ability to Complete and Manage the Project

- Quality of the project plan

SCORING AREAS - Capacity Building

Project Quality and Artistic Vibrancy

 Evidence that the project activities will enhance the organization's ability to carry out its arts/cultural mission

Community Impact and Engagement

 Potential impact of the project on the organization's ability to engage the community.

Ability to Complete and Manage the Project

- Quality of the project plan
